At the 2009 Michigan Pest Management Association Winter Meeting, The Michigan Pest Control Association voted to update the name of the Association to The Michigan Pest **Management** Association. The members agreed that Pest Management better reflects the changes in the industry.

Another by-laws change that passed was to change the requirement for Life Membership. A member no-longer has to retire from the industry to be eligible for Life Membership. The members agreed that many people work well passed the retirement age and should not be penalized for continuing to serve the industry. The MPMA Board of Directors and members want to be able to recognize members for their contributions and dedication to the industry.
